**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 4437, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. SHADEGG OF ARIZONA**

At the end of title VI, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 6. INCREASED CRIMINAL PENALTIES FOR DOCU-**
2 **MENT FRAUD AND CRIMES OF VIOLENCE.**

3 (a) DOCUMENT FRAUD.—Section 1546 of title 18,
4 United States Code, is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)—

6 (A) by striking “not more than 25 years”
7 and inserting “not less than 25 years”

8 (B) by inserting “and if the terrorism of-
9 fense resulted in the death of any person, shall
10 be punished by death or imprisoned for life,”
11 after “section 2331 of this title)),”;

12 (C) by striking “20 years” and inserting
13 “imprisoned not more than 40 years”;

14 (D) by striking “10 years” and inserting
15 “imprisoned not more than 20 years”; and

16 (E) by striking “15 years” and inserting
17 “imprisoned not more than 25 years”; and

18 (2) in subsection (b), by striking “5 years” and
19 inserting “10 years”.

20 (b) CRIMES OF VIOLENCE.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—Title 18, United States
2 Code, is amended by inserting after chapter 51 the
3 following:

4 **“CHAPTER 52—ILLEGAL ALIENS**

“Sec.

“1131. Enhanced penalties for certain crimes committed by illegal aliens.

5 **“§ 1131. Enhanced penalties for certain crimes com-**
6 **mitted by illegal aliens**

7 “(a) Any alien unlawfully present in the United
8 States, who commits, or conspires or attempts to commit,
9 a crime of violence or a drug trafficking offense (as de-
10 fined in section 924), shall be fined under this title and
11 sentenced to not less than 5 years in prison.

12 “(b) If an alien who violates subsection (a) was pre-
13 viously ordered removed under the Immigration and Na-
14 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.) on the grounds of
15 having committed a crime, the alien shall be sentenced to
16 not less than 15 years in prison.

17 “(c) A sentence of imprisonment imposed under this
18 section shall run consecutively to any other sentence of
19 imprisonment imposed for any other crime.”.

20 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of
21 chapters at the beginning of part I of title 18,
22 United States Code, is amended by inserting after
23 the item relating to chapter 51 the following:

“52. **Illegal aliens** 1131”.
