

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5658, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. INSLEE OF WASHINGTON**

At the end of subtitle D of title III, add the following:

1 **SEC. 3__ . NATIONAL DEFENSE RENEWABLE ENERGY**
2 **STANDARD.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary of Defense shall
4 promulgate regulations requiring that—

5 (1) beginning in calendar year 2010, the per-
6 centage of electric energy generated from renewable
7 sources that is consumed by the Department of De-
8 fense in the United States shall increase each year;
9 and

10 (2) in calendar year 2020 and each subsequent
11 calendar year, such percentage shall be not less than
12 20 percent of the total electricity consumed by the
13 Department of Defense in the United States.

14 (b) **CONSULTATION.**—The Secretary shall carry out
15 this section in consultation with the Secretary of Energy.

16 (c) **SUBSEQUENT INCREASES.**—Upon petition or
17 upon the initiative of the Secretary, the Secretary may in-
18 crease the percentage required by subsection (a)(2).

1 (d) ANNUAL EXEMPTION.—On an annual basis, the
2 Secretary may exempt from compliance with this section
3 any entity within the Department of Defense for not more
4 than one year if it is demonstrated that—

5 (1) compliance would represent a national secu-
6 rity threat; or

7 (2) there is a lack of renewable energy re-
8 sources sufficient to meet such requirement.
