**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1904, AS REPORTED
OFFERED BY MR. GRIJALVA OF ARIZONA**

Page 21, after line 8, insert the following:

1 (e) ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS RELATED TO MINING
2. OPERATIONS ON CONVEYED FEDERAL LAND.—As addi-
3 tional conditions of the land exchange under this Act, Res-
4 olution Copper shall agree to the following:

5 (1) To locate and maintain the remote oper-
6 ation center for mining operations on the conveyed
7 Federal land in the town of Superior, Arizona, for
8 the duration of such operations.

9 (2) To actively recruit and provide an employ-
10 ment preference for qualified applicants who reside
11 in the State as of date of the consummation of the
12 land exchange for employment positions related to
13 mining operations on the conveyed Federal land.

14 (3) To ensure that all locatable minerals pro-
15 duced in commercial quantities from the conveyed
16 Federal land remain in the United States for proc-
17 essing and use.

1 (4) To ensure that all equipment used to mine
2 or support mining activities on the conveyed Federal
3 Land is made in the United States.
