In title V, at the end of chapter 3 of subtitle H
(page 609, after line 21) add the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . PILOT STUDY TO MOVE WARNING SYSTEMS INTO**
2 **THE MODERN DIGITAL AGE.**

3 (a) **PILOT STUDY.**—The Secretary of Homeland Se-
4 curity, from funds available for improving the national
5 system to notify the general public in the event of a ter-
6 rorist attack, and in consultation with the Attorney Gen-
7 eral and the heads of other appropriate Federal agencies,
8 the National Association of State Chief Information Offi-
9 cers, and other stakeholders with respect to public warn-
10 ing systems, shall conduct a pilot study under which the
11 Secretary may issue public warnings regarding threats to
12 homeland security using a warning system that is similar
13 to the AMBER Alert communications network.

14 (b) **REPORT.**—Not later than 9 months after the date
15 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit
16 to the Congress a report regarding the findings, conclu-
17 sions, and recommendations of the pilot study.
